Ringette BC Officials Update

To all our Ringette BC Officials,

This communication is for an active referee during the 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 ringette seasons and completed either a Refresher Clinic or Level 1, 2/3, or 4 referee clinic. Ringette BC is hopeful that you are considering refereeing again this season.

2022-2023 Season Updates

Certification and Training

For the 2022-2023 Ringette Season Ringette BC will be hosting one virtual refresher clinic for any officials who did not complete a refresher clinic in 2021-2022. Ringette Canada has extended the refresher clinics to December 2022. If you have not yet completed a refresher and want to become an active official again you <u>must</u> either complete the refresher clinic OR attend a Level 1 or level 2/3 clinic to reinstate your certification as an active official in ringette.

The Refresher clinic is tentatively scheduled for:

- Week of September 12-18
- Hosted via Zoom
- Course hours minimum 4 hours

In addition to the Refresher Clinic Ringette BC will be hosting the following clinics for officials all dates are tentative:

- Level 1 clinics:
 - Week of October 3 to 9 (location to be determined)
 - Week of October 24-30 in TORL
 - Week of November 21-27 in LMRL
- Level 2/3 clinic:
 - Week of November 14-20 (virtual)
- Evaluator Training
 - Week of Community Evaluator clinic October 10-16

Additional courses may be added by request of local and regional ringette associations.

Additional Training Available for Officials:

Ringette BC will be requiring that all officials that are seeking to referee at major competitions for the 2022-2023 season including BC Winter Games and Provincial Championships will be required to complete Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders or an equivalent safe sport training course (options listed below). The cost for completing training is on the official.

Criminal Record Check Information:

All referees are required to complete a valid criminal record check that is current within two years as per the Ringette BC <u>Volunteer Screening policy</u>. A copy of your Criminal Record check clearance should be provided to your local ringette association and to Ringette BC.

Referee Registration Information 2022-2023

Registration Information:

All registration for referees will be done through Ringette BC for the 2022-2023 Ringette season. This is to help with ensuring that our officials have completed the required documentation for participating as an official and to ensure that every official has completed the proper registration process to officiate ringette in BC. Officials will be charged a \$10.00 registration fee from Ringette BC as part of their registration process. This fee will cover your official fee from Ringette Canada and RAMP registration fee.

All officials are responsible for completing the following as part of their registration:

- 1. Completing registration as an official for the 2022-2023 season
- 2. Criminal Record Check (must be current within two years)
- 3. Signing the officials code of Conduct
- 4. Signing a waiver of liability

Registration from the previous season will be voided as of **September 15**. Please ensure that you complete registration in RAMP with Ringette BC before September 15. If registration is not completed by the deadline you will not have insurance for the new season and will not be permitted on the ice to officiate ringette games.
